





Whorled Leaves



Leaves which are "whorled" arise from the same point (at a node) along a stalk. Joe Pye Weed (*Eupatoriadelphus* spp.) has many sets of whorled leaves along its tall stalk. Other plants, like the Large Whorled Pogonia (*Isotria verticillata*), have only one set of whorled leaves.

As we know, California covers a lot of territory. Which means it covers a variety of ecosystems and plant environments. There are printed field guides to each of these regions.

This brings up photos of the plant to assist with confirming your id. As you click on various links associated with the plant, you could also connect with the [Calflora](#) website which shows the distribution of the plant within California.
